### **Blue Milk**

## Star Wars Galaxy's Edge Blue Milk

This recipe is built from the described ingredients and flavor profiles published about the Blue Milk being served in Galaxy's Edge at Disneyland and Walt Disney World.

#### **INGREDIENTS:**

- 2 ½ cups rice milk
- 2 cups frozen pineapple chunks
- 4 tablespoons coconut-flavored syrup
- 2 tablespoons passion fruit flavor
- 1 tablespoon lime flavor
- 1 tablespoon watermelon flavor
- Blue food coloring



### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1. In a blender, add the rice milk and the frozen pineapple chunks. Blend until smooth; add more rice milk to get your desired texture.
- 2. Next, add all the flavorings! If you don't want to use flavoring for the lime and watermelon, you can use squeezed lime juice and pieces of fresh watermelon.
- 3. Add blue food coloring until you get the desired galactic blue color. Enjoy, while imaging you are visiting Galaxy's Edge!

Blue Milk Variation (courtesy of Mr. Food Test Kitchen)



### **INGREDIENTS:**

- 11/2 cups coconut milk
- 1 cup rice milk
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1 (0.22-ounce) packet blue raspberry lemonade drink mix
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 3 cups ice cubes

#### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1. In a blender, combine coconut and rice milks, sugar, lemonade drink mix, vanilla, and ice cubes.
- 2. Blend 30 to 60 seconds or until slushy and well combined, scraping down sides as needed. Serve immediately.

#### TEST KITCHEN TIP:

Since this is a slushy drink, it's best to serve it right away. However, if you do need to keep it chilled for a bit before serving it, pop it in the freezer (yes, right in the blender) and make sure you stir it occasionally. If you leave it in for more than an hour or so, it will probably set up and not be pourable.
