


# of northern indiana National STEM Day

### Egg Drop Project





With an adult, see how Mentos candy reacts with soda. Search the internet for tips and techniques for this fun experiment, such as making a rocket car. Why does that reaction happen? Why does diet soda have a more intense reaction?

## DIY Lava Lamp

Make your own lava lamp at home using household materials! With just a clear container, oil and water, you can learn about how liquid density and polarity works. Add some alka-seltzer and watch your lava lamp react!



## Rock Canay Science

Using just a few simple items, you can make your own rock candy at home with science! A saturated sugar solution is placed in jars with sugar coated sticks. The sugars attach to the stick forming sugar crystals that you

can eat!
