How much do you know about the states that make up our council? Complete activities to learn about the state of Indiana.

Requirements:

- Daisy and Brownie- Complete FOUR Activities
- Junior- Complete SIX Activities
- Cadette, Senior, Ambassador- Complete ALL Activities
- 1. Learn the State Tree, Flower, Bird, Song, Flag, Nickname, and State Holidays.
- 2. Select one Native Indiana Artist, Author, Inventor, Politician, Actor or Composer. Learn about them and their work and share what you have found with others.
- 3. Make a map of Indiana. Locate on this map where you live, where the Girl Scouts of Singing Sands Council's main office is located, and other points of interests your group knows about. (Example: State Parks, Airports, etc.)
- 4. Learn about a few of the Indiana State Parks, where they are, how many there are, how they came about, and how they got their names.
- 5. Learn historical facts about Indiana, such as when Indiana became a state, important people who make Indiana History, things for which Indiana is most known, and how Indiana got its name.
- 6. Arrange for a storyteller or parent to tell stories at your troop meeting about real Indiana women past and present.
- 7. Make a collage or mural about Indiana to share with others.
- 8. Plan an observance and celebrate an important day in Indiana History. Show a film or do skits to tell about this day.
- 9. Learn a song or a game about Indiana that was written by an Indiana Composer.
- 10. Select one Indiana County, trace it on a map, and find out as much as you can about it and share your information with your group.
