- Attend orientation and preparation meetings prior to the National Council Meetings, including webinars
- Be willing to present the 2026 NCS proposals to council membership, including but not limited to the 2026 Annual Celebration Event / Annual Meeting
- Plan to attend all 2026 National Council Sessions in Washington, D.C.
- Be willing to report back to council membership, including, but not limited to the 2027 GSNI-M Annual Celebration Event / Annual Meeting
- Be a citizen of the United States of America
- Be a registered member of the Girl Scouts and fourteen (14) years of age or older by April 26, 2025.

GSNI-M will pay the National Council Session/Convention registration fee, transportation fee, shared hotel fee for three (3) nights, and meals during NCS for elected delegates.
