ITEMS NEEDED FOR DAY CAMP – CAMP LON-I-DAW

CLOTHING:

.....Camper may wear shorts, but it is recommended that long pants be provided in the event that the weather changes suddenly. It has been known to do that at camp!

.....Rain gear and boots for rainy days.....a large garbage bag will do, we do have shelter to get the girls into in case of nasty weather.

.....Shoes that tie and socks are required, please do not send your daughter to camp in slip on shoes. Absolutely no crocs or croc-type shoes.

All girls are expected to stay for the overnight on Thursday unless a letter is sent to camp with your daughter stating that she is not staying. This letter must be presented to the camp director so later than Thursday a.m. There is no bus on Thursday p.m. or Friday a.m. Camp continues from 9 a.m. on Thursday until 3 p.m. on Friday. Primitive unit stays overnight on Wednesday as well as Thursday. There is a parent program on Thursday evening, your daughter will be disappointed if you are unable to attend. **All campers must be signed out of camp each day, so please find your daughter and her unit leader in order to do so. Bus riders will also have a sign out sheet, parents must sign out with the bus driver.**

EQUIPMENT:

.....Unbreakable plate, cup, bowl and “silverware”, all should be boilable and carried in a dish dunking bag. (Mesh bag such as a hosiery bag, must have a string for hanging.) No paper plates or cups. Please do not send “special” dishes or silverware, they have a tendency to get lost at camp!

.....Sack lunch the first day only (drinks will be provided). Please provide a drinking cup on Monday. A water bottle or canteen is recommended, as the girls are active and require lots of liquids while at camp.

.....Primitive unit - pocket knife is needed all week.

THURSDAY – BRING FOR THE OVERNIGHT

Plastic ground cloth Sleeping bag or bedroll Small pillow if needed Flashlight (good battery)
Change of clothing Insect repellent Personal gear(soap, wash cloth, towel, toothbrush, toothpaste, comb or brush).
Please do not send stuffed animals, radios, MP3, video games, PSP or cell phones. Do not send snacks to camp with your daughter, all food and beverages are provided.

NO SUITCASE-MARK ALL ITEMS WITH YOUR DAUGHTER’S NAMES. If she is unable to carry her gear, please re-pack.

If for any reason camp must be cancelled, this will be announced on WLKI early in the morning. Please do not call the radio station. Camp will operate in the rain unless it appears to be a severe storm.

If your daughter will be coming to camp other than the assigned location and time, the day camp director must be notified in writing before camp begins.
